Trustee Carr gave his report on what he observed attending the Morrow County Commissioners meetings this past month.

SBAR 022506 – Proposed bylaws & deed restriction review process – this SBAR was withdrawn by the originator.

Consent Agenda Approved by the Candlewood Lake, Inc. Board of Trustees

Stewardship

SBAR 022504 – Exterior Improvements Policy Change

The Candlewood Lake, Inc. Board of Trustees accepts the recommendation of the Environmental Control Committee to adopt the stated policies regarding exterior improvements. Specifically:

- 1. The ECC may require a pre-construction meeting as warrant-ed on any exterior improvement permit application.*
- 2. Effective after approval of the new fees by the community vote, all exterior building improvements and additions permit applications that are 500 square feet or greater require a \$1 per square foot (i.e. 500 sq ft garage addition = \$500 fee, 1,000 sq ft addition = \$1,000 road fee) road fee payment in addition to the standard permit fee (currently \$614 for a garage and \$512 for a room addition.)*

SBAR 022508 – One-way Roads

The Candlewood Lake, Inc. Board of Trustees President McCray rules this SBAR should be withdrawn as there was not a quorum at the Maintenance Committee meeting and therefore this was not a proper committee vote.

SBAR 022511 – Roadway Improvements Bid Award

The Candlewood Lake, Inc. Board of Trustees Approved the award of the 2025 Roadway Improvement Contract to Mc.B Paving, LLC for the estimated price of \$810,576.00. All overages will be pre-approved by K.E. McCartney and Management before they are implemented. Any overage total amount of \$40,528.80 (5%) must be approved by the Board before implementation. Funds for this project will come from the Primary Reserve Fund.

Governance

SBAR 022512 – Proposal for a Fresh Start on Deed Restrictions and Bylaws Amendment Considerations

The Candlewood Lake, Inc. Board of Trustees accepts the recommendation to delay Board and ballot action on proposed amendments to the Association's deed restrictions and bylaws as being a prudent approach allowing for thorough review, community engagement, and careful consideration of the potential

implications. It ensures that any changes that may be made are in the best interests of the Candlewood community and support its long-term goals and stability. By taking the time to deliberate and plan, the Association can make informed decisions that enhance the quality of life for all residents.

SBAR 022502 – Request to Place Items on April Member Ballot
This SBAR was withdrawn.

SBAR 022510 – Bylaws/Deed Restriction Addition on Amending Legal Documents
The Candlewood Lake, Inc. Board of Trustees tables this SBAR at the request of the originator.

After a proper motion and second, the Board discussed putting the amendment to Article X and the two new proposed deed restrictions regarding Multiple Lot Ownership and Spec Home Limits as passed in the June, 2024 Board meeting on the ballot. After discussion this motion was withdrawn by the originator and the second.

Open Comment Period

- One member, who is also a member of the Bylaws and Governing Documents Committee, spoke of her concern with cer-

tain comments made by Board members regarding the work of that committee.

- One member spoke on additional information which she felt should be considered in accepting bids from contractors.

After proper motion and second the Candlewood Lake, Inc. Board of Trustees approved Adjournment from Regular Session 9:35 p.m.

Next Meeting - The next scheduled regular meeting is March 24, 2025.

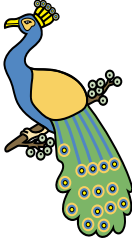

OHIO LAW PROHIBITS OUTDOOR
OPEN BURNING IN RESTRICTED

AREAS FROM

MARCH 1 - JUNE 1

FROM 6 AM - 6 PM

PER O.A.C. 3745.19

Burning is limited in the Spring due to the abundance of dry fuel on the ground. Winds can make a seemingly safe fire burn more intense and escape control.

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SIGN POLICY

Before placing any political signs on your property this spring, please review the CWLA Sign Policy regarding political signs. The entire Sign Policy can be found in the CWLA Information Handbook on pages 12 & 13.

Political signs may be placed on private property no sooner than 30 days prior to election day (May 6, 2025) and must be removed no later than 3 days after the election.

Political Sign Policy: May be placed on private property and may not exceed 6 sq. ft. Signs may be placed no sooner than 30 days prior to the elections and must be removed no later than 3 days after the election. CWL will remove all political signs and if not claimed will be destroyed. There is no charge, but a sign permit will be required. We suggest only one (1) sign per candidate be put out so as not to crowd the designated area. Political signs may be put up by members only (Board Policy 10.162.02)

Sign Permits are free and can be printed from the website or picked up in the Association Office.

How Can CWL Members HELP Candlewood Lake and Preserve Our Water Quality?

Start by Using Phosphorus-Free Fertilizers.

Candlewood Lake has approximately 8,000 acres of watershed that flows into our lake and a big percentage of that is farmland, which can be characterized as "disturbed" areas where storm water crosses impervious surfaces and picks up phosphorous, among other pollutants. These sediments wash into the local streams and into our Lake, bringing phosphorus attached to the soil particles.

The Sediment, along with the phosphorus is what CWL is dredging out of Candlewood Lake all summer long.

How can CWL members help stop this transfer of phosphorus into the Lake? By using a lake-friendly fertilizer that does not contain phosphorus.

Phosphorus-Free Fertilizer: What do I look for?

The three numbers in fertilizer bags show the N-P-K nutrient analysis (N = Nitrogen, P = Phosphorus & K = Potassium). A "zero" in the middle means it is phosphorus free

Will phosphorus-free fertilizer keep my lawn green and healthy?

Yes! Soils in most parts of Ohio already have an adequate amount of phosphorus to grow a healthy lawn. In these instances, adding more phosphorus with fertilizer is not needed and will not benefit your lawn.

What else can you do to protect water quality besides using a phosphorus-free fertilizer on your lawn?

Fertilizers, leaves, grass clippings, animal waste, and eroded soil are all sources of phosphorus. When they are swept or washed into the street or nearest storm drain, they end up in our lake.

Please bag them or place them in an area where they won't be swept into the street or nearby stream.

You can do your part to protect water quality by doing the following

Apply fertilizer at the recommended rate.

Fall is the best time to apply for good results.

Don't fertilize before a storm.

Never apply to frozen ground.

Yard waste can contribute significant amounts of phosphorus to waterways. Keep soil, leaves, and lawn clippings out of the street, ditches, storm drains, streams and lake by bagging them, composting them, or leaving them right on the lawn as a natural fertilizer.

Mow higher. Keeping your grass length to 2½ - 3 inches is healthier for your lawn - and means you can mow less often!

Pick up pet waste. Pet waste can contain harmful bacteria as well as phosphorus. Flush it in the toilet or place in the garbage.

Control soil erosion around your house and on the roads.

When left bare, soil is easily washed away with rain, carrying phosphorus with it. Soil erosion can be prevented by covering exposed soil with vegetation or mulch.

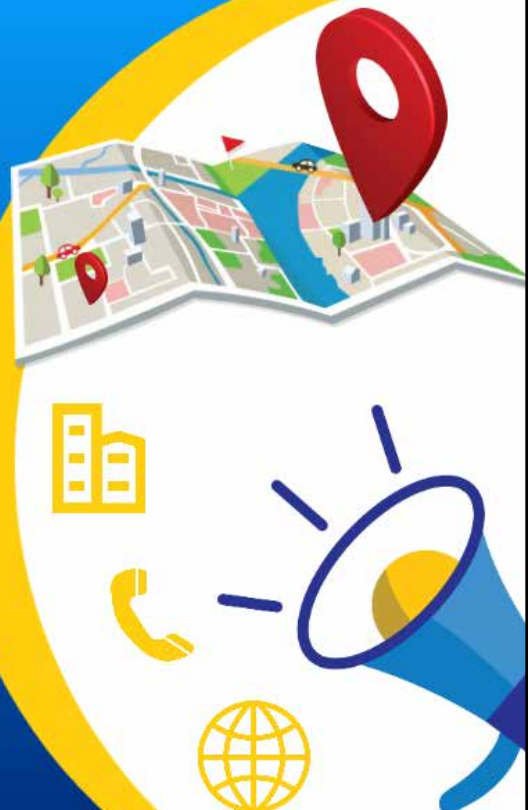

2025 Watercraft Permitting

All Candlewood Lake watercraft permits will expire April 2025. The Security Department is currently permitting boats to be used on Candlewood Lake.

To make the process more convenient for members Security has eliminated inspections and will not require boat titles or motor titles only for the following:

- Current members with 2023 CWL watercraft permits (pink stickers)

The exception to this rule is new members who have never registered a boat at Candlewood, and members with newly purchased watercraft that have not previously been permitted. These watercrafts will require Security inspections and required motor and boat title paperwork.

- Members must complete the required permitting form and turn it into the Security Department at the Main Gate and pay their fees.

- Members will be given their permit sticker and a paper indicating where to attach their new sticker on their watercraft.

Watercraft Permitting Forms are on the Important Information page of the CWL website.
