Governance

SBAR 042507 – Multiple New Home Building Permits

The Candlewood Lake, Inc. Board of Trustees accepts the recommendation to amend Section 105 of the Environmental Control Committee (ECC) Handbook as follows:

Effective January 1, 2026, no more than one new home building permit will be issued to be in effect at the same time for any Person owning a lot or lots within Candlewood Lake. For this purpose, a Person means an individual, sole proprietorship, partnership, corporation, limited liability company, unincorporated society or association, trust or other entity, and includes any "affiliate" of such Person, where "affiliate" means any Person directly or indirectly controlling, controlled by, or under common control with, any such Person, and any officer, director, manager or controlling person of such Person.

SBAR 042503 – Committee Attendance

The Candlewood Lake, Inc. Board of Trustees directs that the Board-adopted Committee Handbook be amended to include language requiring 75% attendance annually for any committee member or allow the committee chair to grant committee members a short-term leave of absence so as to not count against a quorum when a committee member informs the committee chair in advance of knowingly being unable to attend committee meetings for an extended period causing the committee member to be

unable to meet the 75% of stated meeting attendance requirement.

SBAR 042506 – Committee Handbook Additions and Amendments

The Candlewood Lake, Inc. Board of Trustees accepts the recommendation to add more clarity to the Committee Handbook on quorum formation by way of adding the quorum information attached here, as well as to amend the handbook to include the clarifying edits attached here.

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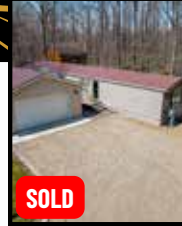

Allergen Awareness

Anaphylactic shock is an allergic reaction that can be deadly if not treated right away. Call 911 immediately for any symptoms, even if symptoms seem to improve.

Allergan's can include peanuts, eggs, shellfish, latex, insect venom, dust mites and countless more.

Symptoms may start out mildly, like a runny nose or an uneasy feeling, but they can get much worse very fast. In severe cases, people collapse, stop breathing, and lose consciousness in just a couple of minutes. If stung, symptoms may typically appear within minutes to hours and possibly one or two days.

WebMD identifies the 4 stages of anaphylaxis as:

- 1) Your symptoms are mild. You might not know yet if you're having an anaphylactic reaction.
- 2) Your symptoms are now worse and on more of your body.
- 3) As your symptoms get worse, you may have trouble breathing.

- 4) Your symptoms are now life-threatening.

What to do while waiting for medical assistance: If the patient does not have an epi pen and has been stung, remove the stinger(s) if there are any, put ice on the sting(s), provide Benadryl per package instructions, lay the person flat preferably in a spot that is cool or shaded. Do not allow them to stand or walk. If the patient is suffering from an allergy that is closing their airways, help them keep quiet and as calm as possible and encourage them to breathe slowly, deep breaths in and out. DO NOT place a pillow under their head, this can block the airways. If the patient stops breathing, Quora.com advises "Use compression-only CPR. The Handler/Dispatcher can talk you through exactly what to do if this is necessary."

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ENUMERATE ENGAGE

In 2023, TOPS, the software company used by CWLA, was acquired by Enumerate. Since that time small changes have taken place that members may not have noticed.

Last week a big change was implemented by Enumerate that impacts all our members. You may have received an email from Enumerate on behalf of CWLA regarding ENUMERATE ENGAGE – this is not a phishing or scam email, it is legitimate.



Members are encouraged to follow the link provided in the email and join the Enumerate Engage platform. You can also download the app to your phone to keep account access at your fingertips.

If you previously used TOPS Owner Access to view your ac-

count(s) and make payments, this system replaces that.

Like TOPS, Enumerate Engage allows members to:

- View their account(s) to see account activity, including the addition of charges and payments.
- If you have multiple lots that you pay on, you will see a drop-down list of them to choose from allowing you to toggle between them.
- Make payments.

This new platform will allow the Association to expand future offerings to members including posting forms privately to your individual account and posting “dynamic forms” that members can complete and submit electronically.

• NOTE: if you are enrolled in automatic ACH payments of your monthly dues, this does not impact or change that.

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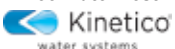
