Board of Trustees Summary of July 28, 2025 Meeting

President's Announcements - President Melton announced the dates of two Board Meetings to be held in Unit 4; October 25, 2025, and April 25, 2026. The next regular Board meeting will be August 25, 2025, at Harmon Lodge.

General Manager's Report - General Manager Ingegneri provided a report for the June 2025 period. His report included updates on Real Estate Sales, the Reserve Program expenses YTD, current cash balances, Dam projects, collection efforts, administrative highlights, and summaries of department activities. The report included a new summary of lots in CWL per unit broken down by unit/types and ownership. The summary will be expanded to include any changes each month.

Financial Report - Treasurer Romelfanger provided a color-coded Executive Summary indicating with green and yellow an overview of revenue and expenses to date. Detailed reports are available on the Candlewood website.

Morrow County Government Observer's Report

- Trustee Carr presented a summary of the topics recently discussed at the commissioners meeting. The commissioners approved a ballot for a 10-mil renewal levy for Jobs and Family Services. A recent study determined the average value of a home in Morrow County is \$375,000.

Open Member Comment Period - Member Marcello Cutrupi spoke regarding the condition of the tennis courts. He distributed photos of the areas of concern. He questioned who was responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of the courts, noting that there is a layer of grit built up and cracks with weeds growing within. GM David Ingegneri advised that upgrades to the courts are scheduled in the current reserve study. For the maintenance of the courts at this time, the GM will review with the Pool and Recreational Facilities Committee.

Member Cutrupi also requested clarification regarding the current placement of the buoys in the lake. He noted that these are not placed as they have been in the past in areas around the island and various coves. President Don Melton Jr stated that he would take this to the Lake and Siltation Committee for review and invited the member to attend the meeting.

Member Temple spoke regarding fishing around Whetstone Creek below the CWL Dam area. According to Temple, fishing has always been allowed in that area, yet now there is a new restriction against it. Temple stated there have been numer-

ous calls from members to the ODNR with no verification of a restriction by the ODNR. GM Ingegneri advised that Security Supervisor Joe Butler has been asked to map the areas that would be acceptable for fishing. In addition, David noted that there are safety concerns to be considered as highlighted in the Dam Ownership Fact Sheet-Public Safety Concerns at Dams. Trustee Kanagy made a motion to immediately allow fishing at the lower part of the south side of the dam area until further review is completed. Fishing is to be restricted on the North side of the dam and on the dam itself. Motion was passed - 8 approved to 1 abstention vote.

Approval of previous meeting minutes: After proper motion, and a second, minutes from the June 23, 2025, Board of Trustee meeting were unanimously approved as written. After proper motion to discuss, Minutes from the July 24, 2025, Special Meeting passed with noted revision to correct to add Trustee Brown to the attendance list by a vote of 7 approve to 2 abstentions.

Old Business:

Feb 2025 SBAR 022520 Bylaw Deed restrictions attorney rewrite by C Brown-Trustees C Brown, D Meissner and President Melton Jr. are to meet to review the status of this SBAR.

March 2025 SBAR 032502 Gate F mailboxes is currently on hold pending further review and additional information.

June 2025 SBAR 250602 Bylaw and article language from LRP (September 2025) will be brought back to the Board in September.

SBAR 250701-Committee appointment/departure-

After proper motion, and a second, the SBAR was unanimously approved as written with Committee member additions and departures noted.

SBAR 250702- Brought by Long Range Planning regarding sale of single CWL owned lots. President Don Melton Jr described history and reasoning behind the recommendation that CWL may not sell single CWL owned lots unless they are contiguous lots and sold to current owner; and no sale of single wooded lots. Meissner questioned if the subject had been presented to other committees that may have an opinion on the subject. Her suggestion that in the future, the opinions of all possibly affected committees be sought before an SBAR is brought before the Board. After proper motion, and a second, the SBAR was defeated by a vote of 7 against, 1 approved, 1 abstention.

SBAR 250703-July 4, 2026 Fireworks. GM Ingegneri explained the background regarding the SBAR. The proposal is to contract now with Great Lakes Fireworks for July 4, 2026, at a cost not to exceed \$25,000. Trustee Meissner questioned the possibility of partnering with the owner of Philomena's next year for the fireworks display, Trustee Carr questioned the budgeting of the \$25,000 in the 2026 budget, Trustee Heenan questioned the locking in of \$25,000 this early in the year and Trustee Kanagy noted that next year is the 250th anniversary of the US and a very big event for the country. After proper motion, and a second, the SBAR passed by a vote of 6 approved 3 opposed.

SBAR 250706-Revision to maximum members of Community Events Committee - Trustee Heenan explained the request to change the Committee Handbook to remove the limit of a maximum number of committee members to 9 from the Community Events Committee only. Because this committee oversees over 150 events throughout the year, numerous volunteers are needed. After proper motion and a second, the SBAR passed by a vote of 8 approved 1 opposed.

Deputy Sherer memorial park update: Trustee Kanagy reported that member Frazee reports funds are now collected, and he is ready to move forward. Trustee Kanagy has asked Frazee for a report with final plans, expenses, and measurements.

Member Comments: Member Cutrupi asked about the content of the fireworks agreement. Does it specify how many fireworks, or will it be for whatever they can provide at the time for \$25,000? David stated that the agreement was for the length of the display. Member Cutrupi agreed that next year is a very special year for the country and committed to a \$5,000 donation from his firm. Those in attendance applauded his offer.

Adjournment

Following proper motion, a second, and discussion, the Board of Trustees of the Candlewood Lake Association, Inc. voted to adjourn.

Next Meeting

The next scheduled regular meeting of the Board of Trustees will be August 25, 2025, at 7pm at Harmon Lodge.

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Second Quarter Financial Update

We are halfway through our fiscal year and our financial results for Operations and Reserves are both good. For Operations, we are outperforming our budget as our actual expenses are lower than budget by \$95,000 through July. If these results hold up for the next 6 months, we will look to transfer any excess Operations funds to Reserves as we did last year.

Reserve contributions are on target with budgeted amounts and our actual Reserve expenditures are just slightly under what we had budgeted, again a good result. We still have about \$800,000 in additional Reserve projects planned for this year including a sub-

stantial renovation of the Unit 4 shower house, water tower repairs and replacement of the north docks this fall.

Our Reserve study updates are complete, and we will be sharing those results in a town hall meeting in the coming months along with our preliminary 2026 budget. Our budgeting process has started, and our first draft will be presented during our September Finance Committee Meeting.

CANDLEWOOD LAKE DREDGING

Our dredging operations have been very successful this year. In some areas we have removed 3' – 5' of silt material. We will continue to work around Turtle Island (we are more than halfway around the island) and then move to the North Dock area to dredge that area before the installation of the new boat docks later this fall.

2025 Year to Date as of 8/25/25 -
422 loads equaling 3,376 cubic yards
of silt removed. Estimate for year-
end over 5,000 cubic yards.

2024 -- 1,816 cubic yards of silt
removed. Dredging stopped in June
due to equipment failure.

2023 – 4,568 cubic yards of silt
removed.

2022 – 4,040 cubic yards of silt
removed.

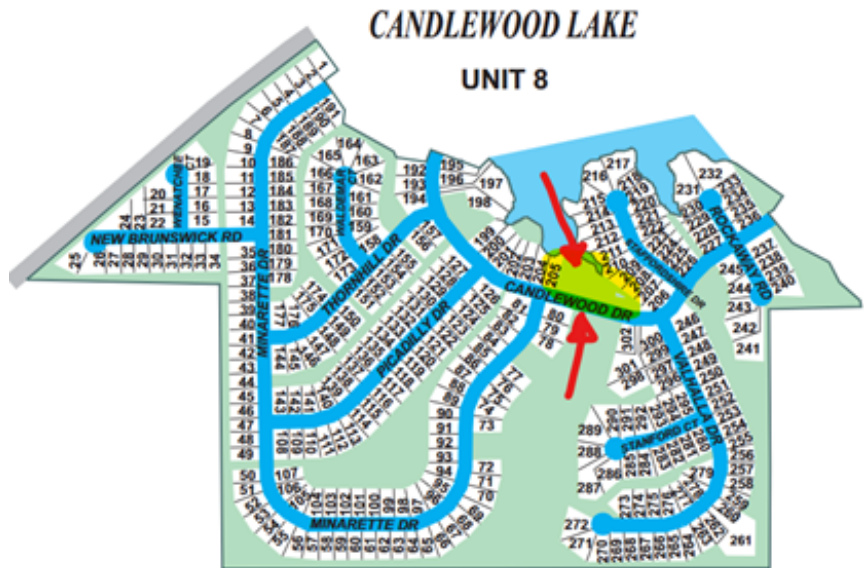

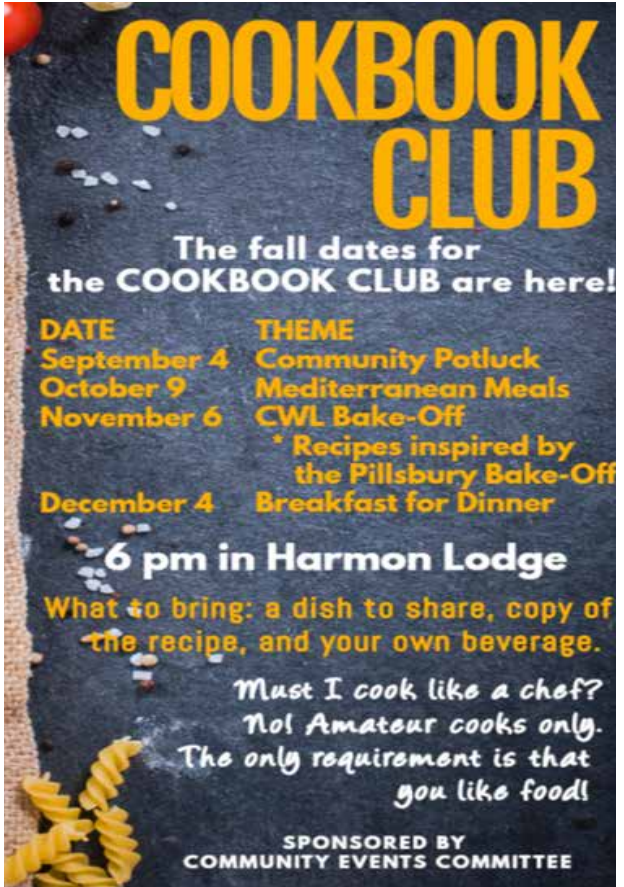
